New Features Released:

- QR Code Scanning: Attendees will receive a unique QR code, similar to a boarding pass, via our web app. Sponsors can instantly scan it to add the Attendee to the roster and check them in, ensuring a quick entry process and eliminating clerical errors. See a quick demonstration here.
- Duplicate Courses: Sponsors can now easily duplicate courses with just a click, saving time and effort.
- Send all VOAs with One Click: Sponsors can send Verifications of Attendance (VOAs) to all Attendees with a single click, streamlining post-event tasks.
