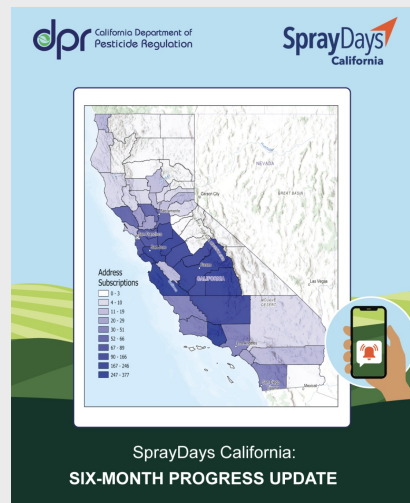
PARTICIPATE IN A SURVEY TO HELP US BASELINE THE RAT ISSUE
